The Kansas County Clerk's and Election Officials Association is taking scholarship applications from those students that are majoring in Journalism, Political Science, or Communications. The Scholarships are available to High School Seniors or College Freshmen or Sophomores.

The monies from these scholarships are made available by the effort put forth by local Elections Officials of the State of Kansas. They are asked to call a toll free telephone number and report to the Voter News service, specified races in the General Election.

The Voters News Service collects and tabulates a single, accurate set of election returns for broadcast and publication throughout the nation and abroad for the Associated Press, CBS News, ABC News, NBC News and United Press International.

Due to the joint efforts of the County Clerk's and Election Officials, Secretary of State's Office and the Voters News Service, the Scholarship Committee will be awarding 10 scholarships in the amount of \$500.00.

Applications may be picked up at the County Clerk's Office, or from the school Counselors from each school district. All applications must be returned to your local county clerk or mailed to Inge Luntsford, 130 N. Spruce, Kingman, KS 67068, on or before April 2, 2010.

The scholarship will be announced at the County Clerk's and Election Officials Associations Seminar in May. The County Clerk from the recipient's county will notify the scholarship winner.
