Inquiries were received specific to hair salons – all in attendance agreed that provided they limited the number of clients at any one time, they should be allowed to remain open. They are not locations for “mass gatherings”. Riley County had reached out regarding the differences in their openings & closings and those of Pottawatomie County. All were in consensus to maintain the order passed on Saturday.
 The Commissioners verified the plans for the Commission meeting scheduled for 8:30 a.m. Monday, March 23, 2020. This meeting will be conducted by Zoom Meeting to ensure abidance with the Kansas Open Meetings Act. The only people allowed in the room are the three Commissioners, the County Administrator, County Counselor, County Clerk, and Nathan Bergman, for the bid opening process.
 Clarification on how Public Works’ employees will have their temperatures taken and reported. Section Patrolman and other field workers will be authorized to take their temperatures at home and send a picture in for recording.
 We should stay in contact with those off work due to quarantine, isolation, or fevers. The Director of Human Resources, will reach out to them to ensure their needs are being met. Any concerns will be brought to the Emergency Operations Center (EOC) and/or the Commission.
