**Health:** Lisa Kenworthy reported:

Five positive with no new active, four pending test, total testing in the County 98. KDHE reported 1,494 State wide an increase of 68, 76 deaths an increase of 7 as of today. In Kansas, the highest cases are showing up in age ranges of 45-64.

Executive Order 20-18: extending stay at home order until mid-night May 3, 2020. If the order is lifted the State will re-open in stages.

Executive Order 20-16: Art and Crafts are not essential, only for fabric for making masks. Clothing and foot wear only essential for uniforms. Veterinary grooming not essential but vet care is. Outdoor activities: garage sells not essential, no joy riding unless in same resident and cannot stop. Fairs if happenings they will be closely monitored.

Executive Order 20-23: Addressed adult care home guidelines.

KDHE testing: lab testing is accurate, the question for false/negative is was the testing done according to guidelines.

Family Planning Clines have been canceled within the Health Department.

Emergency Medical has received calls from adult care facilities needing masks, gloves, gowns, etc.

Cities: no concerns

**Emergency Medical:** Hal Bumgarner reported they are doing all right, looking at alternative protocols.

**Fire:** No updates, just busy with mostly grass fires.

**Law Enforcement:** Shane Jager reported no issues and they are down to 10 in the jail. Looking at concerns with possible a party.

**HR:** nothing new

**Commission:** Weixelman said the County has been lucky. McKee said she has been setting in on the Governors reports. Riat said he was grateful for all the emergency workers.
