Pottawatomie County added one new positive case late on Friday, April 17, 2020. This brings the total positive diagnosed cases of Covid-19 in Pottawatomie County to six (6). The most recent case is self-isolating and working with the County Health Officials to identify close contacts and places visited. The Health Department will reach out to individuals and/or businesses that need to take steps related to interactions with the individual.
