JOIN OUR TEAM

Pottawatomie County EMS (PCEMS) has expanded its coverage area to include areas inside the city limits of Manhattan.

PCEMS operates out of 5 separate stations and the annual call volume is over 2,200 a year.

Pottawatomie County EMS offers paid in-house continuing education hours taught by our own Paramedics and EMT's as well as education by outside agencies.

Prospective employees will need their Kansas certifications for EMT, AEMT or Paramedic.

Each level requires specific certifications:

- EMT: BLS
- AEMT: ACLS, PALS/EPC, BLS
- Paramedic: ACLS, PALS/EPC, BLS

Pottawatomie County is one of the fastest growing counties in the state of Kansas with over 800 square miles and a population of more than 24,000 citizens.

In addition to the Headquarters location in Wamego, there are stations in St. Marys, Westmoreland, Onaga and the Blue Township area east of Manhattan. Each station provides home amenities. We currently operate with five primary ambulances and two back-up units.

Pottawatomie County EMS currently operates with 30 full-time staff members and several PRN positions that support our service. Crews operate in 3 shifts and each crew works two days on/four days off (48/96 hour shifts) with no residency requirements.

PCEMS provides emergency and non-emergency transports and transfers to area hospitals in Wamego, Manhattan, St. Marys, Onaga, Topeka, and Kansas City.

911 emergent calls are the majority of the call volume. PCEMS also provides standby medical assistance at sporting events, local celebrations and festivals.
